MATERIALS DESIGN (THESES)

Requirements for abstracts:

The volume of the abstracts should be 1 page in A4 format, margins: 2 cm at the top and bottom, 3 cm at the left, 1 cm at the right, 1 cm paragraph, 1 cm; font Times New Roman, 12 pt., after 1 interval. The first line is the name of the work in capital and bold letters, centered; below - the surname and initials of the authors in lower case letters, in the center; below - institution, department, city, country, in lower case letters, in the center. In the title of theses are not allowed abbreviations.

The content of the abstract should reflect: introduction, purpose, research methods, results, conclusions; Tables and pictures should not be included in the text. The title of the abstract should correspond to the content. The text should be carefully edited. The name of the file is given by the name and initial of the first author, the number of work is indicated if there are several of them. Example: Akramova N.M.1, Akramova N.M.2. As a first author, you can participate in only two theses. Abstracts should be sent in electronic form, indicating the phone number and e-mail addresses of the authors. Abstracts not in accordance with the requirements will not be published.

The deadline for accepting theses is until **July 5th, 2024**. We ask you to send your applications and proposals for participation in the scientific program of the Congress until **June 5th, 2024**.
